

The Nazi Olympics Berlin 1936 Ends Its Run Exhibition Closes at Maltz Museum

January 23 - Free Admission MLK Day

Cleveland, Ohio - January 10, 2011 - The Nazi Olympics Berlin 1936 will take its final steps towards the finish line as it completes its run at the Maltz Museum of Jewish Heritage on Sunday, January 23 for the year, the Museum is offering free admission on Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Visitors can experience the museum on their own or be part of scheduled group tours: "The Nazi Olympics" or "Stop The Hate," focusing on themes of tolerance and diversity within the Museum's permanent collection, An American Story.

Produced by the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, The Nazi Olympics Berlin 1936 takes a stunning look at how world politics, sports, and racism converged in Germany for 1936 Games. Video testimonials from Olympians and boycotters are featured, along with an original torch from that year's Games, historical photographs and film footage. The Maltz Museum has added several items of Owens' personal memorabilia, courtesy of The Ohio State University's collection, including his diary from the voyage to Berlin, one of his gold medals and a trophy won at East Tech High School in 1932.

The Nazi Olympics is presented by the

Cleveland Browns, Cleveland Cavaliers and Cleveland Indians, with support from KeyCorp. The Maltz Museum is generously supported by Cuyahoga Arts and Culture and the Ohio Arts Council. Special thanks to The Ohio State University for the loan of items from The Jesse Owens Collection.

Mentor Public Library and Connect Ohio Offering Free Computer and Broadband Training

Statewide program will provide more than 200,000 Ohioans with free computer training and encourage broadband use

COLUMBUS - Connect Ohio is pleased to announce Mentor Public Library is a partner in the statewide Every Citizen Online broadband training project.

The program recently received \$6.9 million in federal funding, as well as more than \$3 million in assistance and contributions from a number of participating entities across the state, to increase the sustainable adoption of broadband services for more than 200,000 state residents. Free computer training sessions will be provided at public libraries and community colleges throughout Ohio to introduce new users to a wide range of communication, education, and healthcare tools available online. Interested adults throughout Ohio are eligible to participate in the program, which is geared toward first-time computer and broadband users.

Classes are scheduled to begin January 16, 2011, at the Mentor Public Library, located at 8215 Mentor Avenue, Mentor.

The coursework will include three, 2-hour sessions covering computer basics, an introduction to the Internet, and discussions about how broadband can be helpful in daily life.

"The training will have an immediate impact as a workforce retraining tool for job-seekers," said Lynn Hawkins, Executive Director of the Mentor Public Library. "Our team feels that we are uniquely positioned to deliver timely information and training, and we are increasingly filling the gaps that social service agencies are unable to maintain." "This is an incredibly exciting program for Ohio. Currently, just 66% of Ohio households subscribe to

broadband service, leaving more than three million Ohioans on the wrong side of the digital divide," Connect Ohio Executive Director Tom Fritz said. "The Every Citizen Online program is an opportunity to close the gap between those who have computer technology at home and those who do not, preparing state residents without high-speed Internet for a technologically-driven society."

Connect Ohio is a non-profit public-private partnership, whose mission is to see all Ohioans connected to the benefits of high-speed Internet service. Through the Every Citizen Online program, Connect Ohio is assisting libraries and community colleges with the cost of instructors, computers, and public awareness to provide training to as many as 200,000 new users over the next two years.

Other partners in the program include the State Library of Ohio, The Ohio Association of Broadcasters, The Ohio Public Television Stations, Ohio Public Radio, Groundwork Group, the Ohio Public Library Information Network, and a wide variety of libraries and community colleges across the state. Computer companies, such as Intel and Microsoft, have expressed interest in the project and many broadband service providers across Ohio are working to ensure that participants can easily get online by providing special incentives to first-time broadband subscribers who complete the training.

Connect Ohio's American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) matching grant is awarded by the U.S. Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration's (NTIA) Broadband Technology Opportunities Pro-

gram (BTOP). BTOP provides grants to support the deployment of broadband infrastructure, enhance and expand public computer centers, and encourage sustainable adoption of broadband service.
