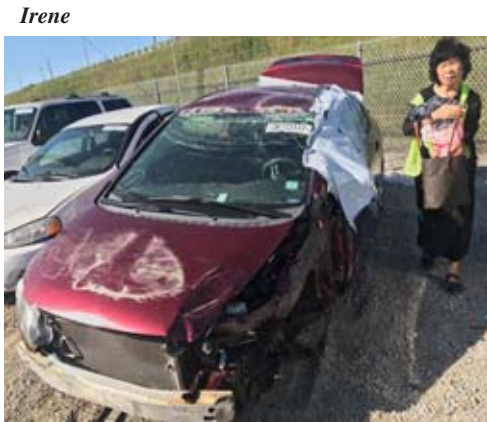


感恩
